What type of drug is it?

Vicodin is a prescription pain reliever that contains hydrocodone (an opioid) and acetaminophen (more commonly known by the brand name Tylenol).

What does it look like?

Vicodin comes in pill form.

How is it used?

Vicodin is consumed orally.

What are its effects?

- dizziness
- nausea, vomiting
- mood changes
- anxiety, fear
- drowsiness
- skin rash
- decreased mental and physical abilities
- hearing loss
- slowed breathing
